We strongly encourage landowners and interested groups and individuals to attend the scoping meetings and present comments on the issues they think should be addressed in FERC's Environmental Impact Study. Those issues, according to FERC, include:

- geology
- soils
- water resources, including surface water and groundwater
- wetlands
- vegetation and wildlife, including migratory birds
- fisheries and aquatic resources
- threatened, endangered, and other special-status species
- land use, recreation, special interest areas, and visual resources
- socioeconomics
- cultural resources
- air quality and noise
- public safety and reliability
- cumulative environmental impacts.

Your comments should be as specific as possible. Also, bring a written copy of your comments to leave with FERC to ensure they are entered into the record accurately.

If you cannot attend a scoping meeting, please send your comments so that the Commission receives them on or before February 27, 2015.
